Current Activities

Training: A new cycle of monthly Emergency Service-related training is poised to begin with the first class scheduled for October. A full schedule is posted on the DAC Calendar. Additional training opportunities are also slated in the coming months.

Medic Training: A Medical First Responder program with a broad curriculum is being established. Certification courses running from First Aid/CPR/AED to Advanced Wilderness First Aid and First Responder courses, Aquatics and other related programs. A Committee and Team Lead have been chosen, researching classes, instructors, and resource requirements. Criteria includes offering as many courses / certification programs as possible, make all offerings open to the public, offer as much instruction over the internet as possible with Hands-
