- ESC Training Tracking: A tracking program needs to be revived. This will lead to award of the BSA Emergency Preparedness pin.
- **FEMA Incident Command / Community Emergency Response Team (CERT):** We would like to initiate a training program to offer courses to Scouts, Scouters and the general public.
- **ESC Website:** We need a website and **webmaster** to help coordinate information and activities. We have collected a significant amount of information available in a Dropbox file and we are in the information loop of several other ESC related organizations but have no efficient way to distribute to the general Scouting Public.

Medic Support & Training (Cristian Joya):

- Medic Training: Medical First Responder program with a broad curriculum is being established. Certification courses running from First Aid/CPR/AED to Advanced Wilderness First Aid and First Responder courses, Aquatics and other related programs. A Committee and Team Lead have been chosen, researching classes, instructors, and resource requirements. Criteria includes offering as many courses / certification programs as possible, make all offerings open to the public, offer as much instruction over the internet as possible with Hands-On final certifications where necessary. Also work to ensure programs are offered throughout the Council and not just in the Denver Metro area.
- Medic Call List: We have no open requests for Medic Support. We currently have 47 people identified on the Medic Call list with training/skills ranging from Basic 1st Aid to Doctors. With this list of volunteers, we have fulfilled every GCC event request we have received. THANK YOU ALL.
- Medic Kits Inventory Standardization: We are working with a variety of sources to establish a set of standard Medic Kit inventories and then stock those kits appropriately. Working on establishing the categories, inventory for each and standardized contracts with supply vendors.
- Mock Exercise Training; GCC participation in a Mock Disaster training exercise is being proposed.

Amateur Radio (George Weber):

- The High Frequency radio antenna at MSR is off-line. We need to find and install a new antenna mast. Similar to the one being used at the Hamilton Scout Center.
- The Hamilton Scout Center Commercial Repeater continues to be out of service due to strong frequency interference. Testing and resolution pending.
- A new High Frequency radio and another dual band (VHF/UHF) radio have been donated to the program. At this time they are both planned to be installed in the Mobile Operations Center trailer.
- We need to get an article on the GCC Amateur Radio Program to submit to various publications including Scouting For Boys, QST, Bryan on Scouting, etc. *Do we have any writers out there looking for a topic?*

Event Support Trailers (Dan Rasco):

- **Mobile Operations Center:** Phase II development continues. We have several new items to install and stock in the trailer including Medic gear, another radio, A-V and IT network and a heater.
 - We are looking for a Laptop donation to support the in-trailer network and radio programming.
- Support Services Trailer: The 4x8 enclosed Support Services trailer is currently functional and available as needed. It is however not water/weather tight and needs refurbishment. Plans are on hold pending availability of skilled personnel.

Incident and Emergency Procedures (John Braselton):

Working to create or update and enhance Incident/Emergency protocols and procedures.
